Anne Gannon has a rich, distinguished and diverse record of public service in Florida. Anne is the Constitutional Tax Collector for Palm Beach County. Elected by an overwhelming majority in 2006 and re-elected in 2008 and 2012. Anne is the first woman to hold this office.

Anne is responsible for the collection and disbursement of over 3 billion dollars in tax revenues and the issuance of REAL ID compliant driver licenses for Palm Beach County. The Agency employs over 290 in its central office and eight service centers that collectively handle over 4,000 customers daily.

Anne top priorities are outstanding customer service, improving agency processes, and increasing operational efficiencies. She has received local, state and national recognition. Anne received the "Excellence In Financial Operations" Award from the Florida Tax Collectors Association and the "Excellence in Government Leadership Award" from the National Association of Government Accountants. In 2010, Anne was invited to speak about her innovations and quality management at the International Deming Research Center at Fordham University.

Anne was honored to be selected as the 2013 Women In Leadership Award recipient in the Public Sector. She was recognized as a "2012 Palm Beach Achiever" by the *Palm Beach Women's Magazine*. She was honored to receive the 2012 Giraffe Award by the Palm Beach County's Women's Chamber of Commerce. Anne was also selected as a *Florida Weekly* "2011 Palm Beach County Power Women." The newspaper created the headline "Anne Gannon is Not Afraid of Challenges" to describe her passion for public service.

Anne is committed to our community. She serves on and is Chair-elect for the JFK Medical Center Board of Directors for the term beginning January 2014. She was selected Honorary Chair for the 2013 Brain Cancer 5K Run/Walk. She also serves on the Pineapple Grove Arts Board, an arts and shopping district located in the heart of downtown Delray Beach.
